No one will generally agree with this because they will usually have an improper understanding of what the Law is.

If there is a problem with keeping God's Law and people feel that it should be accommodated with or even replaced by our non absolute systems, then humanity has declared that there is a problem with The God, the Almighty. We then will make ourselves God's judge by this kind of thinking. His Law proceeds from His nature although it is in place for our benefit. We aren't doing God a favour by keeping His Law, but there are penalties for breaking it.

Being friends with the unconverted, Law-breaking or sinful world can make ourselves enemies of God,

and even our prayers will be treated as abominable, and as if coming from the enemy.

We protect the individual, the family, the nation and the whole planet by completely obeying God's Law and system of order.

The Covenant of God

The Laws of God in His Covenant are at the heart of humanities acceptable worship of the One True God.

We are to keep the Law that provides us with liberty from all kinds of fear and want, but it also acts as our judge.

James 2:12 So speak and so act as those who

are to be judged under the law of liberty. (KJV)

This body of Law is not too difficult for us to keep.

Deuteronomy 30:10-11 if you obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which are written in this book of the law, if you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul. ¹¹ "For this commandment which I command you this day is not too hard for you, neither is it far off. (KJV)

The Commandments of God are NOT too hard for us to obey in what is spoken of as the letter or the simple physical application and obedience to the Law.

Proverbs 6:32 The one who commits adultery with a woman is lacking sense; He who would destroy himself does it. (NASB)

They are not too difficult today anymore than they were in the day they were given. Our Father did not give us a body of Law that we are unable to keep, and then punish us severely when we fail.

The gift of and our receipt of the Holy Spirit from Pentecost was granted because we, who are under the renewed covenant, must keep the spiritual intent of the Law as it is magnified in its

application. This now will even include our thoughts and our intentions and not just in the letter and by our actions.

along with our words.

Matthew 5:36-37 "And I say to you, that every careless word that men shall speak, they shall render account for it in the day of judgment. ³⁷ "For by your words you shall be justified, and by your words you shall be condemned." (NASV)

God's promises are dependable and He does not ask too much from any of us.

1Corinthians 10:13-14 No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, that you may be able to endure it. ¹⁴ Therefore, my beloved, flee from idolatry. (NASV)
